

- 5. How has the Lord called you to "leave your water jar" (things in your life) to follow His leading?

- 7. How is your story a tool to relate to others, so that they can see Jesus for their self?

- 10. We go to work each day, to gather & provide for ourselves & family.

 What is the work of the Lord & what is He trying to gather through us?

 What is the eternal impact of our obedience?
- 11. Have you ever belonged to something greater than just you?

 How do you feel that your life is an essential part of God's Kingdom?

 How do you see yourself fitting in (any amount is a good amount)?
- 12. How can we have a "harvest mindset" in our life & walk with Christ?
- 13. Did you ever eat at a buffet? How is the ripe harvest before us essentially an abundant food supply to our soul?
