





GENESIS 2:15-25



I. PLACE v7-9

7 then the Lord God formed the man of dust from the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living creature.

22 And the rib that the Lord God had taken from the man **he made into a woman** and **brought her to the man.**




