

Questions

- 4. Do you believe that Jesus is the "only door" or way to salvation and life? What happens to those who belong to another religion? Is Jesus absolutely necessary?

How would you feel if you were one of the Americans or Afghans left behind? (NB: this is not to be political or to criticize the administration of the USA, so do not go there. Deal with the emotions of how you would feel if you were left behind.)
- 9. Can you picture Jesus being your shepherd if you were left behind? What kind of "abundant life" would you want from Jesus to give you if you had been left behind? Faith? Assurance? Peace? Comfort? Grace? Wisdom? Courage? Compassion and love for your enemies? Concern for others more than yourself?
