John 12:37 (NASB)

³⁷ But though He had performed so many signs before them, yet they were not believing in Him.

John 12:38 (NASB) ³⁸ This was to fulfill the word of Isaiah the prophet which he spoke: " LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT? AND TO WHOM HAS THE ARM OF THE LORD BEEN **REVEALED?"**

John 12:40 (NASB) "HE HAS BLINDED THEIR EYES AND HE HARDENED THEIR HEART, SO THAT THEY WOULD NOT SEE WITH THEIR EYES AND PERCEIVE WITH THEIR HEART, AND BE CONVERTED AND I HEAL THEM."

For those who want the original research of hardening of the heart, here are some verses: God hardens = Exodus 4:21; 7:3-5; 9:12; 10:1-3,20,27; 11:10; 14:4,8,17; Lamentations 3:64-65; Ezek 3:8-9 Humans harden their own hearts = Exodus 8:15,32,34-35; 13:15; 1 Sam 6:5-6; 2 Chron 36:11-13; Psalm 95:8-11; Prov 28:14; Prov 29:1; Jer 5:3,21-31 Zech 7:11-14; Eph 4:17-19 Bible simply says "the hearts were hardened" = Exodus 7:13-14,22; 8:19; 9:7 Through preaching of Isaiah = Isaiah 6:8-13 Miracles combined with humans own disbelief = Mark 6:49-52; 16:14 Hardening of the Jews was for the purpose of reaching the Gentiles = Romans 11:25

- 4. Why did the "authorities" who believed in Jesus remain silent? Jn 12:42-43 Why is it easy to fall into the trap of loving the praise of men more than the praise of God?
- 5. What are your beliefs about the statement "secret discipleship is a contradiction in terms: for either the secrecy kills the discipleship, or the discipleship kills the secrecy." Do you believe that these "believers" were true believers? (see John 3:1-2; 19:28-29 were Nicodemus and Joseph of Arimethea "secret believers?"; see also Mt 10:32-33; Romans 10:9-10 and even John 12:24-26 for the opposite side).

6. Can you be a secret believer in Jesus Christ (like a Christian in a Muslim context still going to the mosque or a Hindu who still goes to the Hindu temples and feasts (John 12:42-43)?

7. Jesus' last public message to his people is recorded in Jn 12:44-50. What indications do you find that He is still reaching out in love and grace to those who have rejected him?
