#### Questions

- 1. Describe your own Father. How are you like him? How are you not like him? How was your relationship with him? How does this affect your view and relationship with your heavenly Father?
- 2. What are the traits of a good father? What are the traits that God has that help you connect with your heavenly Father?
- 3. Why is it significant that to know Jesus is to know the Father AND to see Jesus is to see the Father?
- 4. What does it mean for God the Father to be "IN" Jesus, and for Jesus to be "IN" the Father?

#### Questions

- 5. Why do you think the disciples could be with Jesus for so long and still not "really" grasp or know who He was and how He was exactly like His Father in heaven? Why do we as humans struggle to grow in understanding and knowledge even when exposed to the truth for so long?
- 6. What are the greater works that Jesus speaks of in John 14:12-14?
- 7. What would your prayer life look like if you began to pray that everything would honor and glorify the Father and further His kingdom, instead of your wishes or your kingdom?
- 8. What is the relationship between love and obedience (John 14:15)? If we don't walk in obedience with the Lord, what does that imply?
- 9. How can you begin to develop the intimacy of fellowship, communion, or union with the Father that Jesus longs for His disciples to experience like He has with the Father?
