#### The Gospel of Jesus Christ

Problem of Sin: Romans 3:23 (NASB) for all have sinned and fall short of the glory
Penalty of Sin: Romans 6:23 (NASB) For the wages of sin is death but the free gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
God's Provision: Romans 5:8 (NASB) But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.
Repentance: Romans 2:4 (NASB) Or do you think lightly of the riches of His kindness and tolerance and patience, not knowing that the kindness of God leads you to repentance?
Believe in Jesus Christ: Romans 10:9,13 (NASB) <sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; <sup>13</sup> for "Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved."
