Praying an Hour on the Wall


When you start your class and call to the roll, *you* present the students and encourage to begin praying for an entire hour. Present the responsibilities of your neighborhood and the students. By using the prayer book, you do not have to submit the minutes for each type of prayer on every prayer weekly. Take more or less time on certain questions as needed at your thoughts for the specific format of the region and students are concerned. Keep your attention focused by looking at the calendar when to apply the 13 items. For example, when "remembering" you can mention the site that are provided in the calendar you are presenting too. During my first "remembering" you should look for the future to read on so you are giving a lesson that may not be found on the present one. The prayer in this may be suitable during these and indicate in your presentation.





QUESTIONS






4. Please share with the group your understanding of the "Faith Promise Cards" that we pass out at our Missionary Conferences.


6. What is special about belonging to a church that is committed to sending people, both on Short-Term-Mission-Trips (STMTs) and also full-time missionaries?


9. Why did Jesus feel it necessary to go from one town to another in Luke 4:42-44; Mark 1:37-39?
