- 1. Is there a recurring or disturbing dream you have had?
- 2. What is your belief about dreams? Do you believe they are significant? Do you believe that they are purely psychological? Or demonic? Or of God? What Biblical basis do you use to support your beliefs?
- 3. Why do you believe that God gave Nebuchadnezzar, an ungodly king, this dream? Does this line up with the belief by some that God only gives dreams to Christians? Have you heard any reports in these days of non-believers having dreams from God or of Jesus? Please share.
- 4. Why do you think Daniel asked for the prayers and of his godly friends in Daniel 2:17? What benefit would come from others praying to God about a dream?

5. What benefit does Daniel have in taking his request to God in prayer in Daniel 2:18? What other Christian traits does taking our problems, anxieties, troubles, or dreams to God tell about a person? Share how you have received help from the Lord in a difficult time as you went to prayer.

6. Where does wisdom and understanding come from? See Proverbs 2:6 James 1:2-9. What do you learn about wisdom and understanding from these verses?

7. Daniel is a man of wisdom and understanding. Last week, we learned that these come from the Lord and a healthy "fear of God." (see Proverbs 1:7; 10:9-10). In Daniel 2:19-23, Pastor Randy shared that Daniel uses terms and phrases from eight books of the Old Testament and 22 different Scriptural references in his praise of God. Why would being full and knowledgeable of the Word of God be helpful in understanding your troubles, anxieties and dreams?

8. In Daniel 2:28-30, we read that Daniel gives the credit to God and is also humble in that he says no wisdom or power resides in himself. He humble and selfless as he gives the glory and credit to God. Are most of our dreams about ourselves? Or are most of our dreams about others? Why do you think this is?

9. What could be the cause of a recurring dream or nightmare that we have? What should we do about it?
