Questions

- 1. What do you like better: Starting a task or ending it? Why?
- 2. What is the wisdom of "back planning" (i.e. starting a project or goal or life, with the end result in mind and going backwards to figure out the what's and they how's of doing it)?
- 3. For Daniel and his readers, what is the good news in Daniel 12:1-4? What is the bad news?
- 4. What questions do you still have about 'The Tribulation' period mentioned in the sermon?
- 5. What did you learn new about the Tribulation period?
- 6. What did you learn new about the Antichrist?

Questions (continued)

- Concerning the passages in the sermon outline on the second coming and the rapture, what do you believe about the rapture? Pretribulation = Christians will be raptured out before the 7 years of Tribulation OR Posttribulation = Christians will be raptured and raised at the same time at the end of the Tribulation and before the Millennium? What view have you been previously taught? Which view do you drift towards? (Examine the passages of Daniel 12:2; Matthew 24:29-31; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18; 1 Corinthians 15:50-55; Revelation 20:4-6,10-15).
- 8. Do you expect to find your name 'written in the Book' (Daniel 12:1)?

- 9. Of the five ways to respond to the "end times" teaching, which ones challenge and encourage you the most?

- 11. Daniel was told to go on with life even if he didn't understand (see Daniel 12:13). When have you had to cope in faith with the perplexities of life?
- 12. The bottom line for Daniel is that the royal power of the Most High God always triumphs over the kingdoms of men (see Daniel 7:11,26-27; 8:25; 9:27; 10:13; 11:45; 12:13). How is that evident for Daniel personally? For the kings and subjects he treats? For the readers he comforts? For you and your small group?
