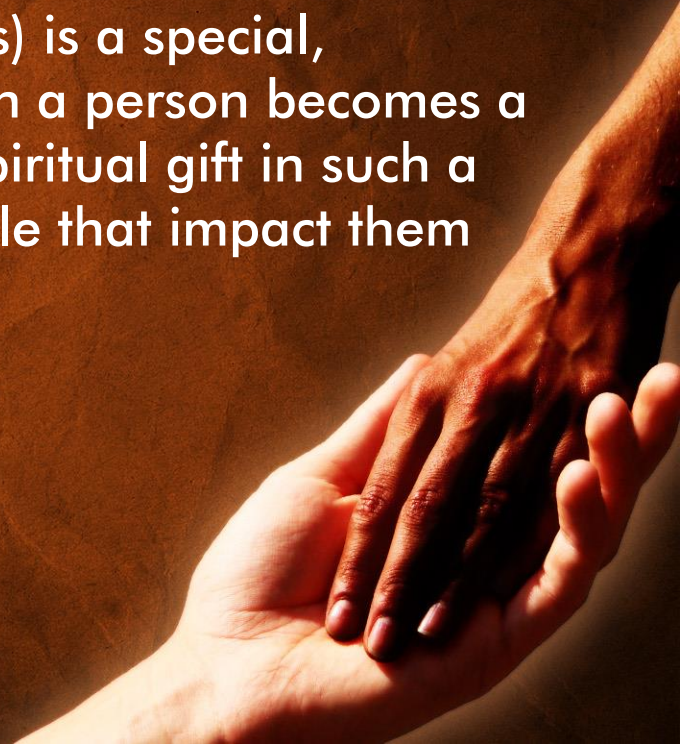

Intro:

Spiritual Gift - Definition:

_____ (write in any of the spiritual gifts) is a special, supernatural gift given by the Holy Spirit when a person becomes a Christian. It enables that person to do that spiritual gift in such a way as to produce results (fruit) in other people that impact them in a spiritual way.

At Salvation

1 Corinthians 12:7 (NASB) ⁷ But to each one is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

1 Corinthians 12:11 (NASB) ¹¹ But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually just as He wills.

Romans 12:6 (NASB) ⁶ Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith;



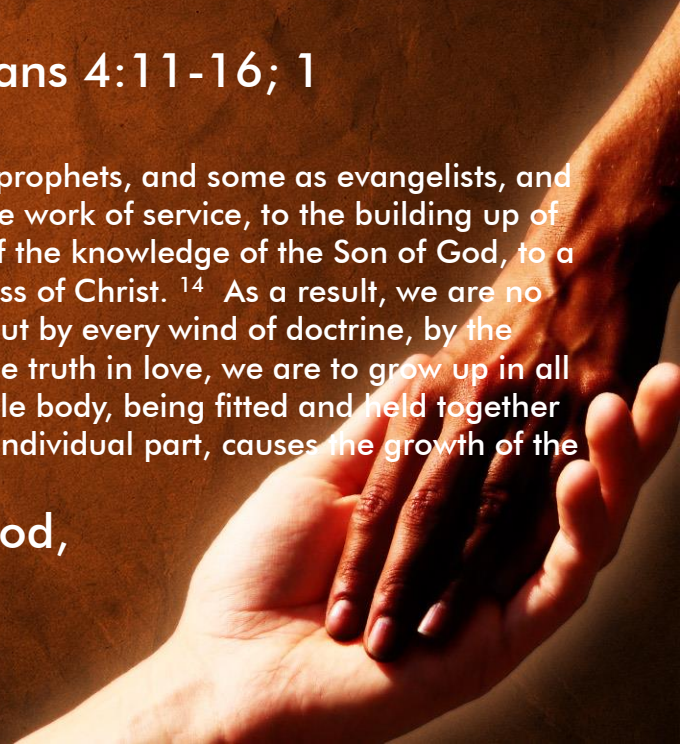

II. We Need To _____ Others With Our Gift(s) 1 Peter 4:10b “...employ it in serving one another...”

A. People - Believers & Unbelievers Ephesians 4:11-16; 1 Corinthians 12:7; 14:3-5,12

Ephesians 4:11-16 (NASB) ¹¹ And He gave some as apostles, and some as prophets, and some as evangelists, and some as pastors and teachers, ¹² for the equipping of the saints for the work of service, to the building up of the body of Christ; ¹³ until we all attain to the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a mature man, to the measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ. ¹⁴ As a result, we are no longer to be children, tossed here and there by waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by the trickery of men, by craftiness in deceitful scheming; ¹⁵ but speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ, ¹⁶ from whom the whole body, being fitted and held together by what every joint supplies, according to the proper working of each individual part, causes the growth of the body for the building up of itself in love.
