





- 7. Is the Old Covenant bad or false or is the Old Covenant inferior and obsolete? Please explain using Hebrews 8:13 and other verses from chapter 8.
- 8. What are the better promises of Hebrews 6:6-12? Why couldn't the Law provide the power to obey but Jesus and the Holy Spirit can?

- 9. How does 1 John 2:20 and 1 John 2:27 tied in with John 14:16-26 relate to Hebrews 8:11?
- 10. What sins still plague you from your past? How does Jesus' blood and dying 'ONCE' satisfy God's justness and righteousness in being able to forgive you? Why do you still "go fishing" in the sea of sins that God has said stop? See Hebrews 8:12 and Micah 7:18-19 Micah 7:18-19 (NASB) 18 Who is a God like You, who pardons iniquity And passes over the rebellious act of the remnant of His possession? He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in unchanging love. 19 He will again have compassion on us; He will tread our iniquities under foot. Yes, You will cast all their sins Into the depths of the sea.

11. Pastor Randy closed the sermon with the illustration of many from our church going to Gabon and becoming familiar with that country. A few Gabonese came to our country and we enjoyed them. The writer of Hebrews is trying to get the Jewish Christians to realize that to go back to Judaism is to forsake the greater and better reality of heaven's experience. Even more than God wanting us to go to heaven someday, He wants us to experience the realities and blessings of heaven this day, in the here and now. Read the following verses and share how these speak of "heaven on earth" now.

Luke 17:20-21 (NASB) 20 Now having been questioned by the Pharisees as to when the kingdom of God was coming, nor will they say, 'Look, here it is!' or, 'There it is!' For behold, the kingdom of God is in your midst." Luke 10:9 9 and heal those in it who are sick, and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.' Ephesians 2:4-7 (NASB) ⁴ But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, 5 even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), ⁶ and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, 7 so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

- Colossians 3:1 (NASB) ¹ Therefore if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.
- Ephesians 1:3 (NASB) ³ Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ,
- Matthew 5:8 (NASB) ⁸ "Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.
- Hebrews 12:14 Pursue peace with all men, and the sanctification without which no one will see the Lord.
