Questions

1 Thess 4:3-7 2 Corin 3:17-18 2 Peter 1:1-11 Phil 2:12-13

2 Corinthians 3:17-18 (NASB) 17 Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty. 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as from the Lord, the Spirit.

Philippians 2:12-13 (NASB) 12 So then, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your salvation with fear and trembling; 13 for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.



For Sins and Sanctification

Questions (continued)

2 Does that mean we have sinless perfection?

Rom 6:6-7 and all of Rom 6:1-23. If this were the case, there would be no exhortations or warnings or rebukes given by the writer of Hebrews. You are good to go!

Romans 6:6-7 (NASB) 6 knowing this, that our old self was crucified with Him, in order that our body of sin might be done away with, so that we would no longer be slaves to sin; 7 for he who has died is freed from sin.



For Sins and Sanctification

Questions (continued)

3 Are there people that are too far gone into sin to be made holy by Jesus Christ? 1 Corin 6:9-11

1 Corinthians 6:9-11 (NASB) 9 Or do you not know that the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor homosexuals,

10 nor thieves, nor the covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor swindlers, will inherit the kingdom of God.

11 Such were some of you; but you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and in the Spirit of our God.

Questions (continued)

4 Is there any imperfection or quirk in my personality, spiritual life, or character that can't be made holy and changed by Jesus Christ? 1 Thess 5:23-24

1 Thessalonians 5:23-24 (NASB) 23 Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you entirely; and may your spirit and soul and body be preserved complete, without blame at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. 24 Faithful is He who calls you, and He also will bring it to pass.

Questions (continued)

5 Are we lacking anything to be holy? He equips us with everything Heb 13:20-21; 2 Peter 1:2-4; Eph 4:11-16

Hebrews 13:20-21 (NASB) 20 Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, even Jesus our Lord, 21 equip you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

Questions (continued)

6 What can thwart God making us holy? the sins listed in the book of Hebrews

7 Are all Christians supposed to be holy? All Christians are called "Saints" in the New Testament. Saints means "holy ones" Heb 6:10; 13:24 Eph 5:25-27

Hebrews 6:10 (NASB) 10 For God is not unjust so as to forget your work and the love which you have shown toward His name, in having ministered and in still ministering to the saints.

Hebrews 13:24 (NASB) 24 Greet all of your leaders and all the saints. Those from Italy greet you.
