How do you need confidence before God today?

- 1. How do you remember all your passwords to log into websites on the internet?
- 2. Would you consider yourself to be a confident person? Where or when do you feel confident and assured? Where or when do you not feel so confident?
- 3. Do you feel confident with coming before God in prayer? In worship? In a small group?
- 4. Why do we need the blood of Jesus and the death and resurrection of Jesus to enter into God's presence?
- 5. Do you sense God's presence during the week? How, where, and when do you experience His presence the most during the week?

6. What does Psalm 15:1-5 and Psalm 24:3-6 have to do with Hebrews 10:22? How does holiness and experiencing the Presence of God relate to one another?

Psalm 15:1-5 (NASB) 1 O LORD, who may abide in Your tent? Who may dwell on Your holy hill?

- 2 He who walks with integrity, and works righteousness, And speaks truth in his heart.
- 3 He does not slander with his tongue, Nor does evil to his neighbor, Nor takes up a reproach against his friend;
- 4 In whose eyes a reprobate is despised, But who honors those who fear the LORD; He swears to his own hurt and does not change;
- 5 He does not put out his money at interest, Nor does he take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things will never be shaken.

Psalm 24:3-6 (NASB) 3 Who may ascend into the hill of the LORD? And who may stand in His holy place?

- 4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, Who has not lifted up his soul to falsehood And has not sworn deceitfully.
- 5 He shall receive a blessing from the LORD And righteousness from the God of his salvation.
- 6 This is the generation of those who seek Him, Who seek Your face—even Jacob. Selah.

- 7. Do you prefer to be alone and worship the Lord or do you prefer to worship the Lord with others? How many times a week do you worship the Lord alone? How many times a week do you worship with other believers?
- 8. With the Triad of Faith, Hope and Love, which of the three do you feel you are strongest in? Which of the three do you feel the weakest in? How could fellowship with others and worshiping the Lord strengthen these three important Christian virtues in your life?

- 9. If entering His presence and staying in His presence throughout the week is so vital for our spiritual lives, why do you think the writer of Hebrews ends Hebrews 10:19-25 with encouraging us not to be absent frequently from fellowshipping with others? What spiritual benefit do you get from being with others and talking about spiritual things around the Word of God and prayer?
- 10. Why is going to church regularly so important? What do we lose if we don't? What does Hebrews 10:26-39 have to do with Hebrews 10:25 and fellowship with other Christians? Why is endurance and persevering to the end so important in the Christian life?
