



- 10 million colors that can be seen by the human eye.



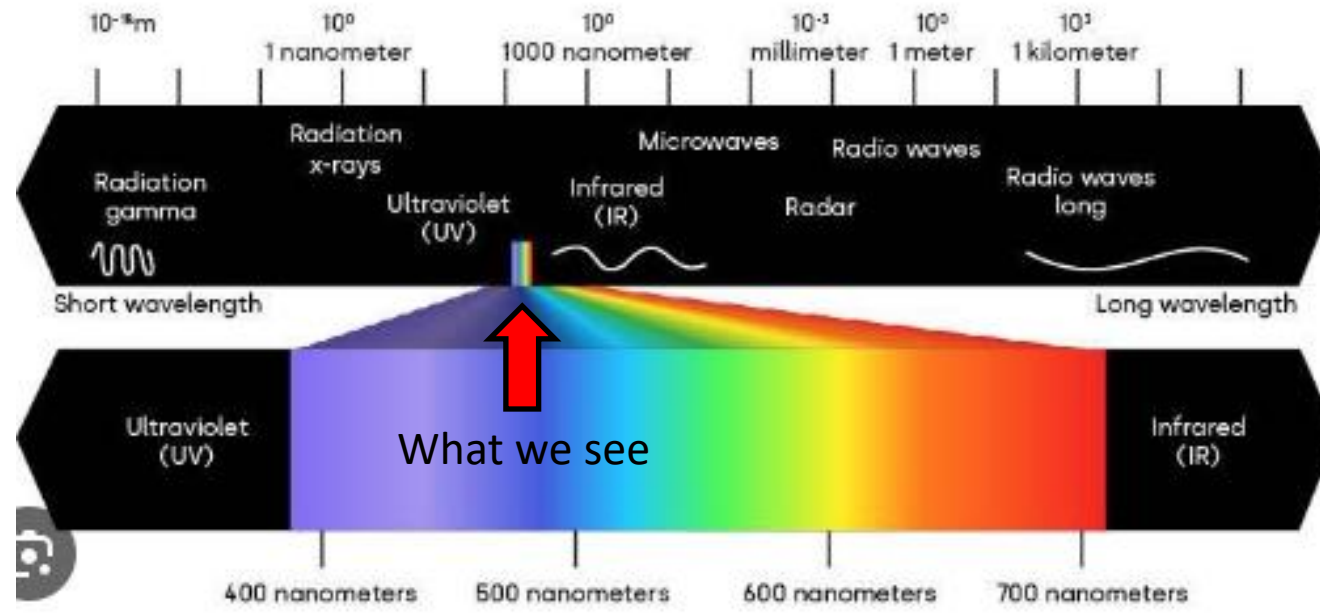
Let's Mix It Up!!!

- Mixing all 3 primaries together, **Red**, **Blue** and **Yellow** makes what color?

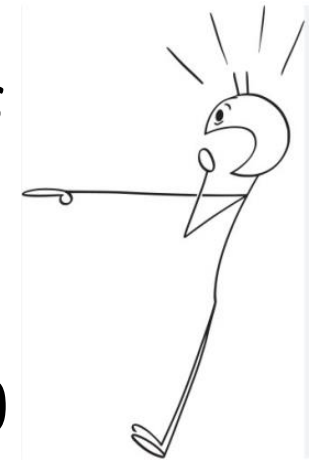
