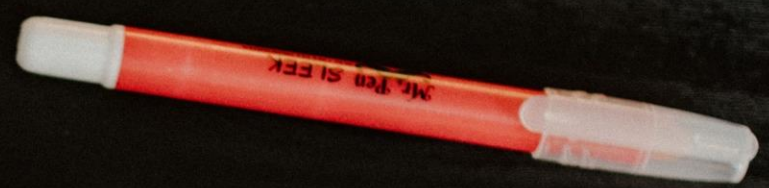

**PSALM 106:32**  
 32 They angered him at the waters of Meribah, and it went ill with Moses on their account, for they made his spirit bitter, and he spoke rashly with his lips.  
 33 They did not destroy the peoples, as the LORD commanded them, but they mixed with the nations and learned to do as they did.  
 34 They served their idols, which became a snare to them, and they sacrificed their sons and their daughters to the demons; they poured out innocent blood, whom they sacrificed to the idols of Canaan.  
 35 Thus they became unclean with blood, and played the whore in their deeds.  
 36 Then the anger of the LORD was kindled against his people, and he abhorred his heritage; he gave them into the hand of the nations, so that those who hated them ruled over them.  
 37 Their enemies oppressed them, and they were brought into subjection under their power.
